## South Queensland Touch Football

### Event Volunteer Opportunity

South Queensland Touch Football (SQBD) is the governing body for all things touch football in South Queensland and Border Districts. SQBD works closely with its affiliated associations to continually develop and grow opportunities to participate in Touch Football from grass roots to the elite across South Queensland. SQBD organises and manages several events across Queensland each year, including South Queensland Primary All Schools (SQPAS) and South Queensland Secondary All Schools (SQSAS)

SQBD require field staff for the upcoming South Queensland All Schools held at **Gold Coast Touch Association** from **23-24 August**.

This is one of our biggest events with over 1,500 participants each day. A breakdown of what would be required across the event can be seen below.

Requirements of QTF Field Staff include:

- Setup and pack down of event venue as per specifications including but not limited to; display of all promotional materials/signage, field markers, equipment etc.
- Inspection of fields before the commencement of games and identify any issues that require attention, reporting any issues to the relevant manager. Issues could include any holes, faded lines or objects on/off fields (within 5 metres) that present a safety issue.
- Ensure that the venue is kept clean, tidy and is presented to the highest standard possible at all times.
- Crowd Control – ensure all spectators comply with the Code of Conduct and Responsibility Code. This includes no spectators on the playing surfaces and/or are safely spectating 5m from any playing surface.
- Welcome participants, provide advice and assistance to participants in a friendly and professional manner at all times.
- Assist Officials, Match Officials if and when required, ensuring Match Officials are at required fields and games commence on time.
- Monitor/ Ensure if Coaches are situated behind the in-goal area (dead ball line), they are not to issue verbal or physical commands. If they refuse to comply, inform Tournament Control.
- Monitor/ Ensure all participants are wearing appropriate enclosed footwear. If they refuse to comply, inform Tournament Control.
